Who: SMS Families & Friends

When: Now through Nov. 24th

Why: To bring comfort & joy to those in need this Advent

How: --Obtain your fleece (see below)

--Cut and tie your blanket; pray for the recipient

--Wrap in a clean trash bag; label it “Blanket”

--Bring to school by Nov. 24th

No sewing! You only need fleece, a ruler, and sharp scissors.

Fleece is easily obtained online or in store at Joann Fabrics, etc. It does NOT need to be seasonal; any colors/patterns are fine. There are many blanket-tying tutorials on the web and YouTube.
